MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

UAB ŠVIESOS GREITIS (managing partner)

and

ENERGY EFFICIENCY CENTER Georgia (EECG) (associate partner)

and

TELAVI MUNICIPALITY (final beneficiary)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) sets for the terms and understanding between the UAB Šviesos greitis, Energy Efficiency Center Georgia (EECG) and Telavi Municipality administration for successful partnership.

BACKGROUND

MOU sets terms and understanding for implementing energy efficiency project, installing to 100 kW solar power plant (PVP) on the Telavi sport school building roof (Project). Project implementation site address is: Telavi, Leonidze St. N 18A. Project should be financed partly (to 75%) by the Lithuanian program for projects on development cooperation with developing countries and partly by the final beneficiary.

This MOU will contribute to the Lithuanian international financing for the implementation of climate change mitigation in the developing country and/or adaptation to the climate change measures and to transfer Lithuanian experience in developing of effective energy efficiency solutions. As final beneficiary is the Signatory of EU Covenant of Mayors initiative, this MOU will also contribute to the obligations to ensure the EU 30% greenhouse gas-reduction target by 2030 and the adoption of a joint approach to tackling mitigation and adaptation to climate change.

OBLIGATIONS OF MOU PARTIES

MANAGING PARTNER:

- shall prepare project proposal for financing institution in Lithuania:
- shall manage overall project activities and put all efforts for successful project implementation;
- shall purchase and transport needed PVP equipment to construction site;
- shall assemble all PVP equipment at final beneficiary site;

- shall organize workshop in Lithuania for target groups on effective PVP solutions and EU policy for energy efficiency obligations (with participation of associate partner and final beneficiary representatives);
- shall introduce the principals of operation PVP and monitoring PVP work;
- shall grant warranty for PVP equipment on separate agreement;

ASSOCIATE PARTNER:

- shall manage all related project activities from Georgian side and put all efforts for successful project implementation;
- shall implement and coordinate activities related with design, getting needed permits for construction, commissioning and putting in operation of installed PVP.
- shall organize workshop in Georgia for target groups on effective PVP solutions and EU policy for energy efficiency obligations (with participation of managing partner and final beneficiary representatives);

FINAL BENEFICIARY:

- shall put all efforts for successful project implementation;
- shall ensure secured temporary (up to two months) storage of PVP in the surroundings of construction site;
- shall contribute financially to project implementation. Form and amount of the contribution shall be agreed after approval of the application for funding from Lithuanian financing institution.
- shall support in all activities related with design, getting needed permits for construction, commissioning and putting in operation of installed PVP.
- shall ensure suitable operation and maintenance of installed PVP equipment;
- shall report annual PVP production to managing partner 3 years after project completion;

ENDORSEMENTS

All MOU parties commit to make efforts for efficient, effective ant timely collaboration to ensure successful partnership for participation in the Project. The MOU parties agree not to enter into collaboration with any other parties for this particular Project.

FUNDING

Form of financial obligation to the Project from MOU partners and final beneficiaries should be confirmed within the additional agreement.

DURATION AND TIMING

This MOU may be modified by mutual consent of authorized officials from partners. This MOU shall become effective upon signature by the authorized officials from the partners and final beneficiaries and will remain in effect until modified or terminated by any one of the parties by mutual consent. In the absence of mutual agreement by the authorized officials from partners this MOU shall end on 31/07/2022.

All MOU parties understand that after signing Project financing agreement with the Lithuanian financing institution, it should be no more than 18 months for finishing all Project activities. Foreseen timing of all Project stages from the start of Project:

I stage, PVP design and permit approval: from 1st to 6th month;

II stage, acquiring PVP equipment and transport to site: from 4th to 8th month;

III stage, installing of PVP equipment at site: from 8th to 12th month; IV stage, PVP commissioning, training of staff: from 13th to 15th month; V stage, informational workshops in GE and LT: from 15th to 18th month;
